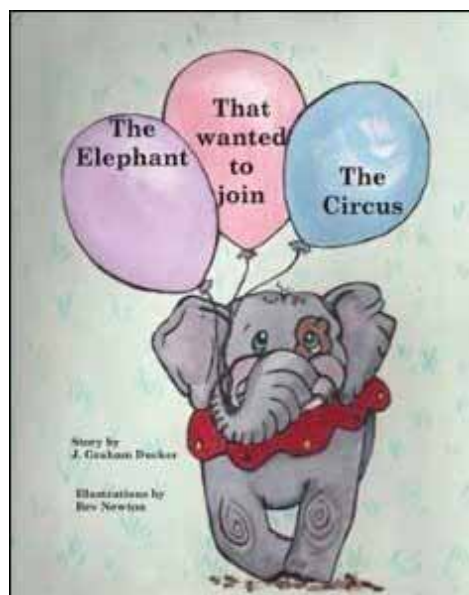


The Elephant That Wanted to Join The Circus
